#### Naaman

**Scriptures: II Kings 5**

**Key Verse: II Kings 5:15 “Indeed now I know there is no God in all the earth, except in Israel;”**

#### **Key Points:**

1. Naaman was a Syrian army commander who had leprosy.
2. His wife had a servant girl from Israel. She suggested that Naaman seek the prophet of God (Elisha) in Samaria to be cured.
3. The king of Syria sent Naaman with a letter to the king of Israel, expecting healing for Naaman.
5. The king of Israel tore his clothes in distress when he read the letter, but Elisha asked the king to send Naaman to him.
6. Through a messenger, Elisha instructed Naaman to wash in the Jordan River seven times to be healed.
7. Naaman was angry because Elisha had not personally performed a miracle to cure him, and he turned to leave. However, his servants urged Naaman to do as he had been instructed.
8. Naaman listened to them, and when he had dipped 7 times in the muddy water of the Jordan he was cured! He praised God.
9. Naaman returned and offered gifts to Elisha, who refused to take them. Elisha’s servant Gehazi followed Naaman and asked for the gifts. When Gehazi returned, Elisha struck him with the leprosy of Naaman.

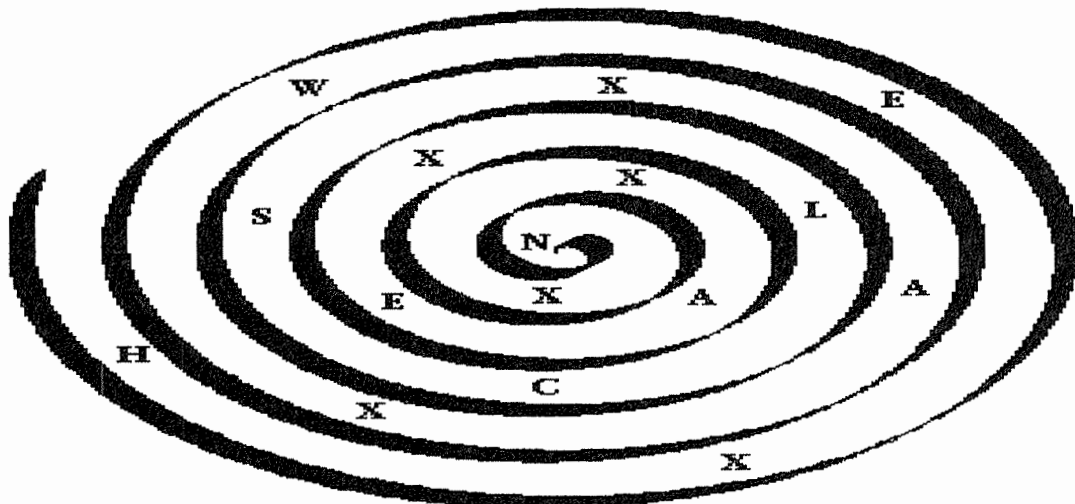

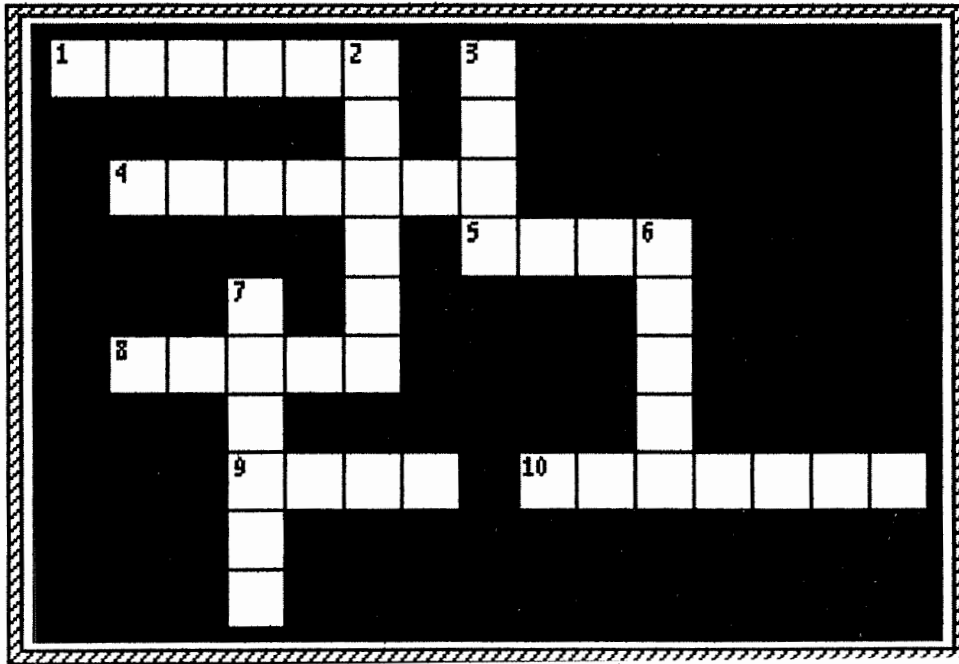

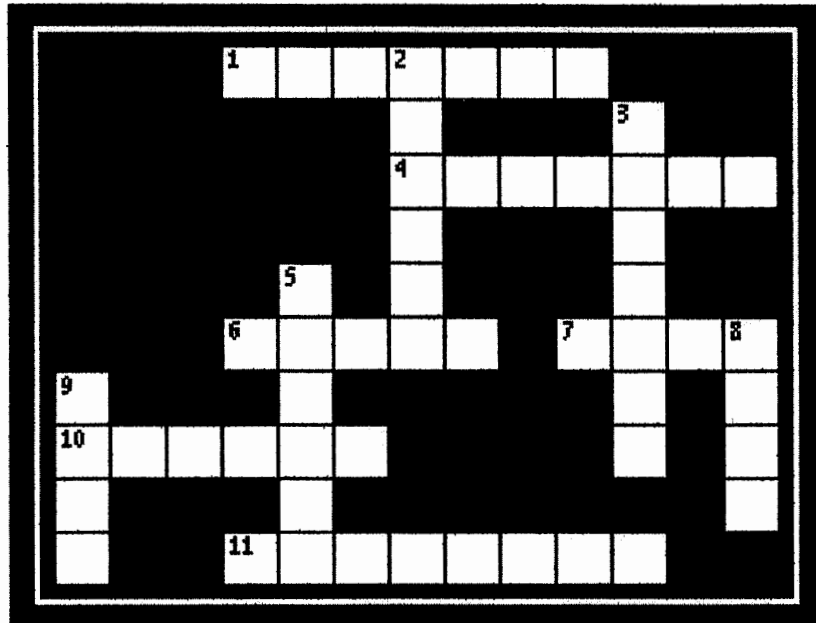
