The Rich Man and Lazarus

Scriptures: Luke 16:19-31

Key Verse: John 14:2: “In my Father’s house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you so. I go to prepare a place for you.”

Key Points:

1. There was a rich man who lived luxuriously, and a beggar named Lazarus who lived at his gates, longing for the crumbs from the rich man’s table while the dogs licked at his sores.

2. Lazarus died and was carried to Abraham’s bosom. The rich man also died. He could see Lazarus from his place in torments.

3. The rich man asks Abraham to send Lazarus to drop cool water on his tongue.

4. When Abraham tells him that there is a great gulf between them and it is impossible, the rich man asks Abraham to send Lazarus to his brothers to serve God.

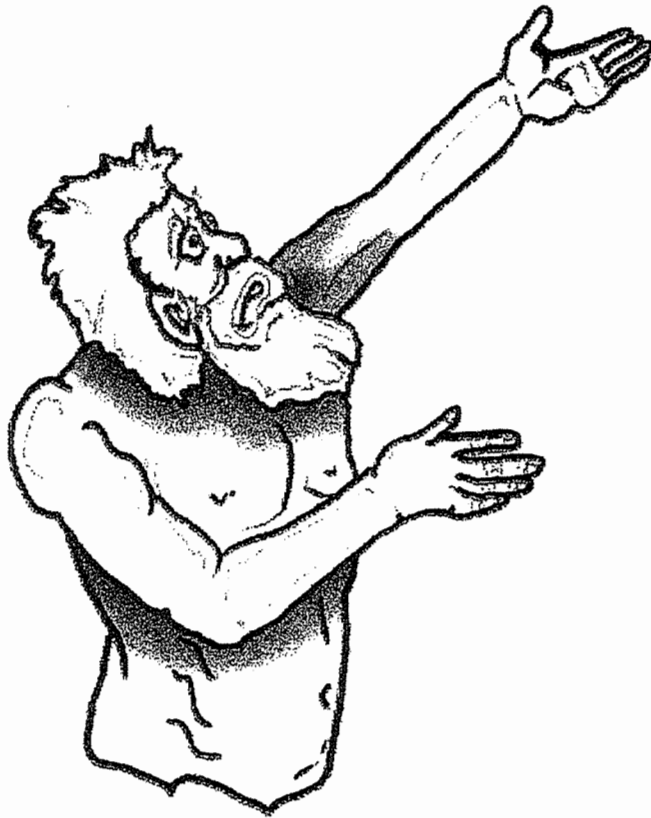
5. Abraham also denies this request, telling the rich man that his brothers have the law and the prophets and they should believe them.

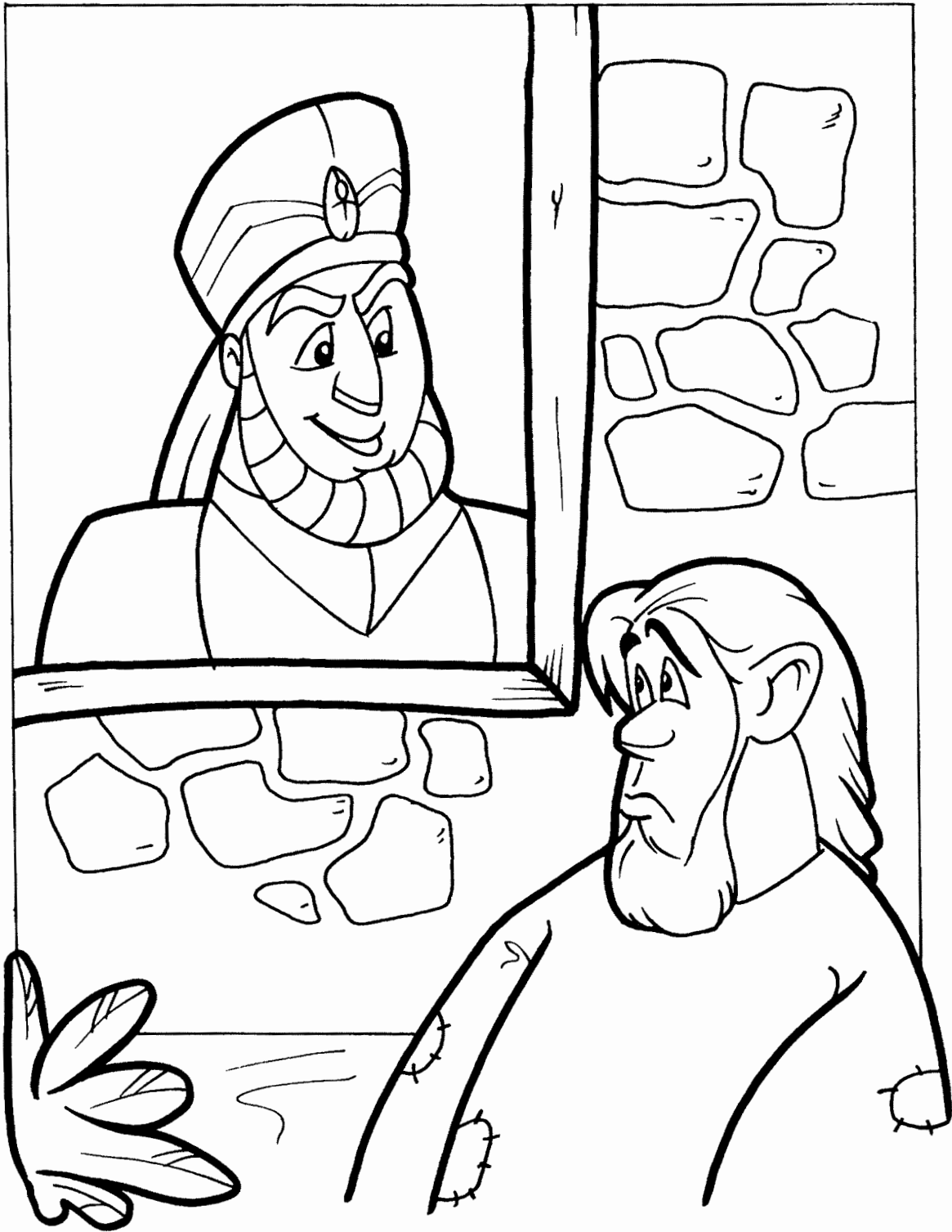

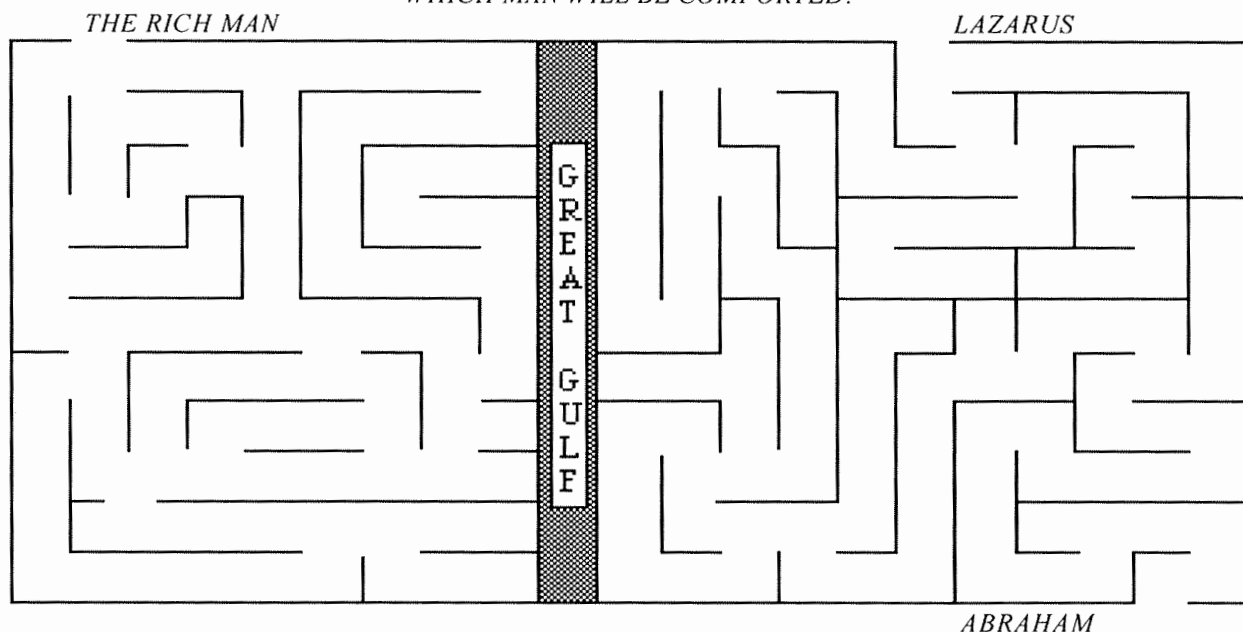

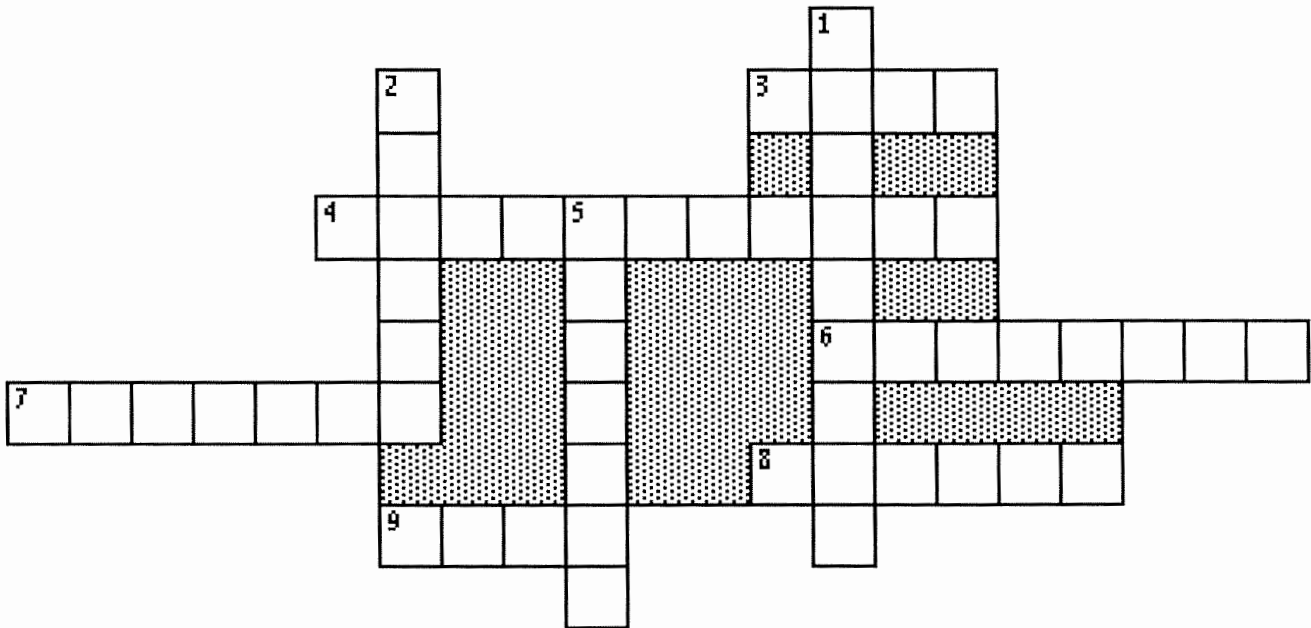
