Last Supper and Lord's Supper Established

Scriptures: Luke 22:1-20, Matt 26:14-29

Key Verse: Luke 22:19: And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them saying, "This is My body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

Key Points:

1. Jesus sends His disciples into Jerusalem to prepare a place to partake of the Passover.

2. Judas goes to the chief priests and makes a covenant with them to betray Christ for 30 pieces of silver. Later, while they are eating the Passover feast, Jesus identifies Judas as the one that will betray Him.

3. Later, while they are eating the Passover feast, Jesus identifies Judas as the one that will betray Him.

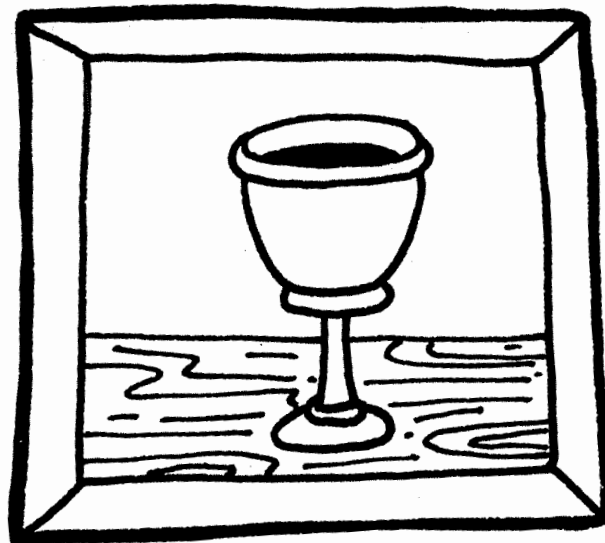
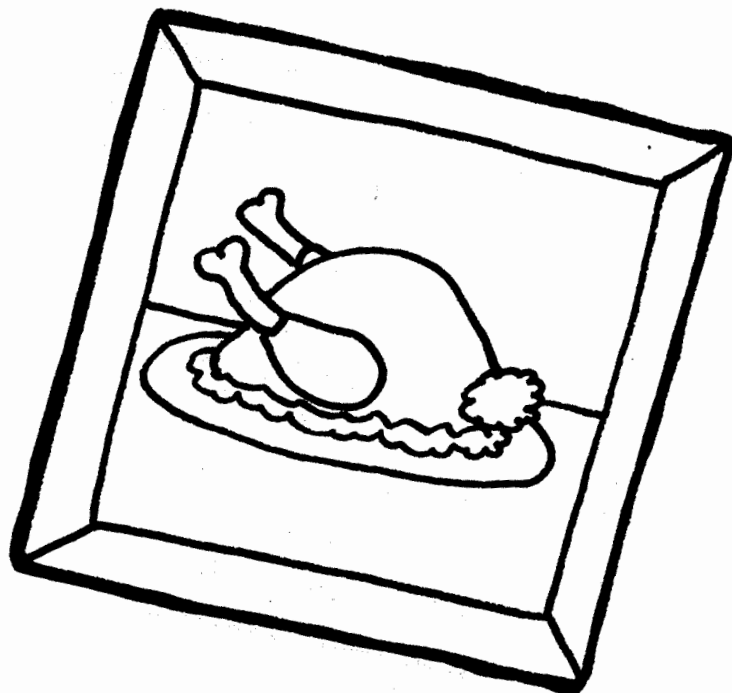
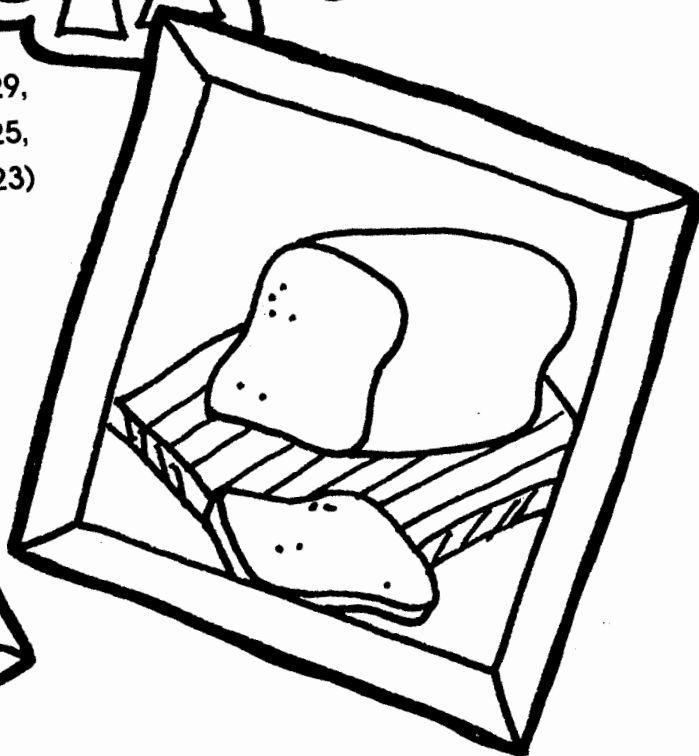
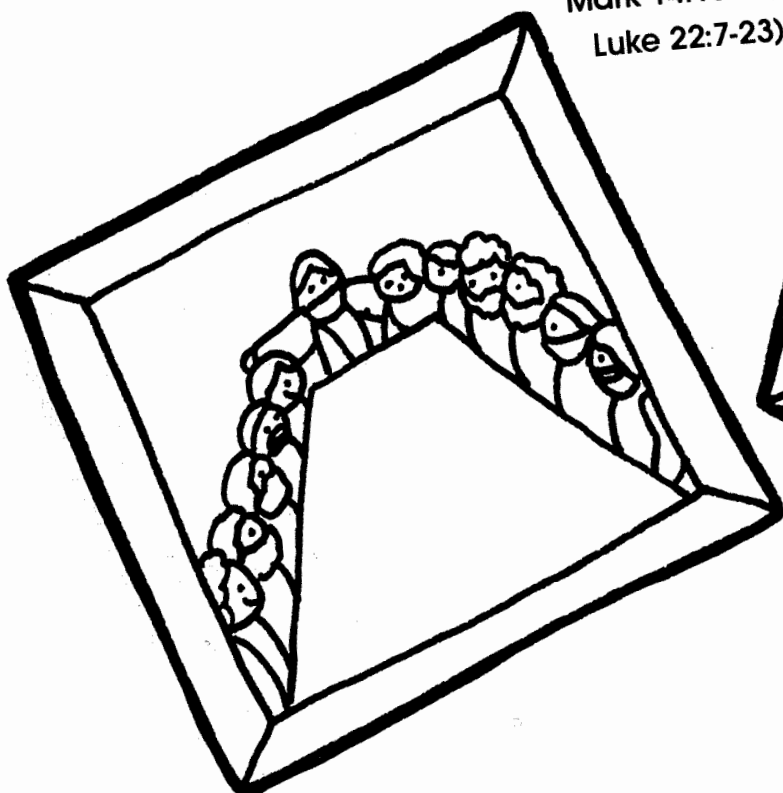
4. Jesus blesses and breaks the bread, giving it to His disciples, and tells them to take and eat, for it is His body.

5. He does the same with the cup, telling them to drink, that it is His blood, shed for the remission of sins.

6. Jesus then tells His disciples that He will not drink this again until He does so with them in the kingdom of heaven.

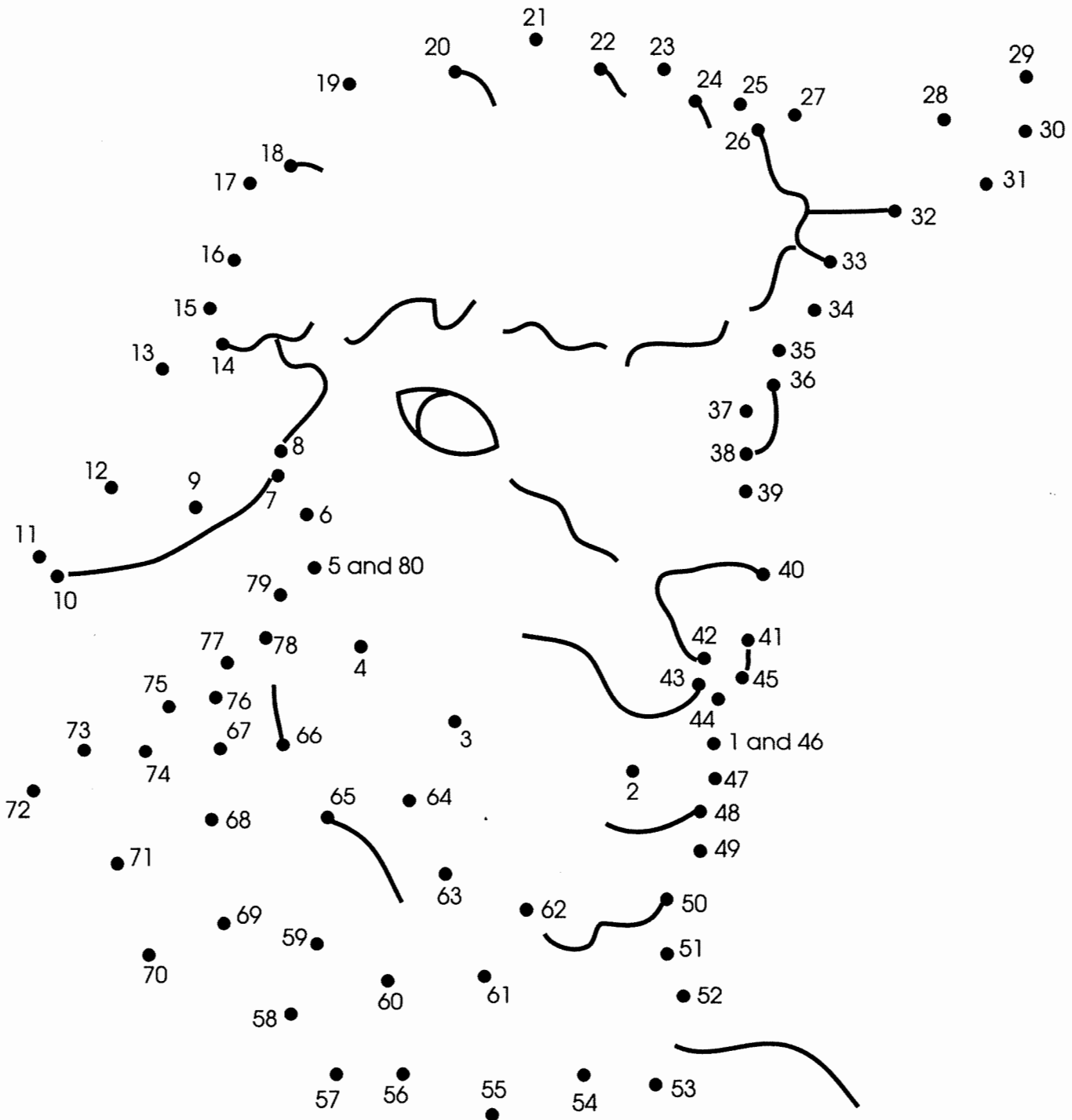


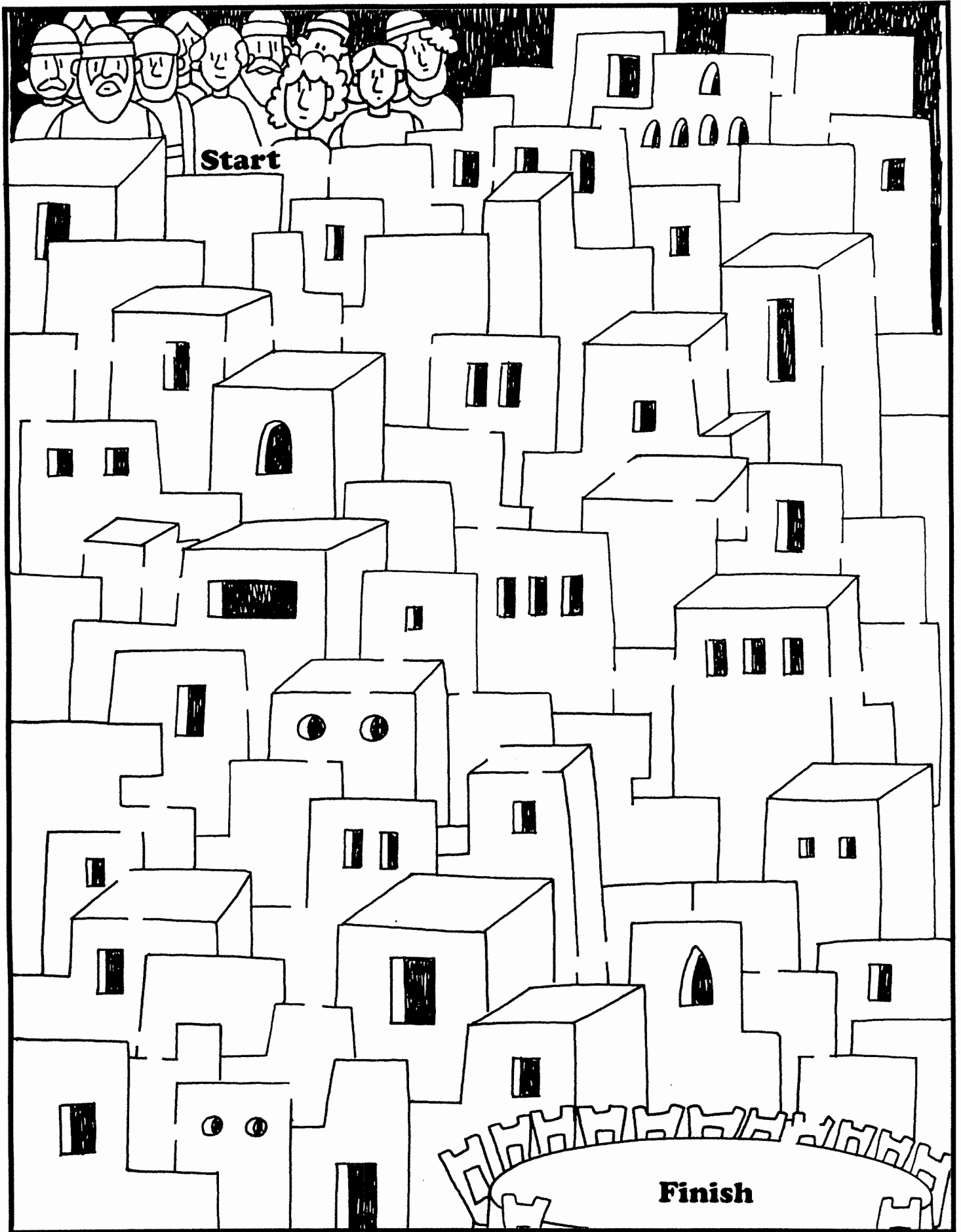

The Lord's Supper

Mark 14:12-26; John 13:18-38

It was the time of the Feast of the Passover, a Jewish festival commemorating the time when the angel of the Lord passed over the homes of the Hebrews in Egypt rather than killing their firstborn sons.

When evening came, the twelve disciples sat down to eat with Jesus. He said to them, "I tell you the truth, one of you will betray me—one who is eating with me."

They were all upset at this news and one by one said to Jesus, "Surely not I?" Judas was the betrayer, but none of the others knew it.

Jesus broke the bread and gave some to His disciples. He said, "Take it; this is my body." Then He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to His disciples saying, "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many. I tell you the truth, I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it anew in the kingdom of God."

Simon Peter said to Jesus, "Lord, I will lay down my life for you." But Jesus knew that His disciples were not as strong as they thought.

"I tell you the truth," Jesus told Peter, "before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times."

Jesus spoke to His disciples with comforting words. He wanted to encourage them for the rough days ahead. Then they sang a hymn and went out together. Judas had already left to betray his master.
