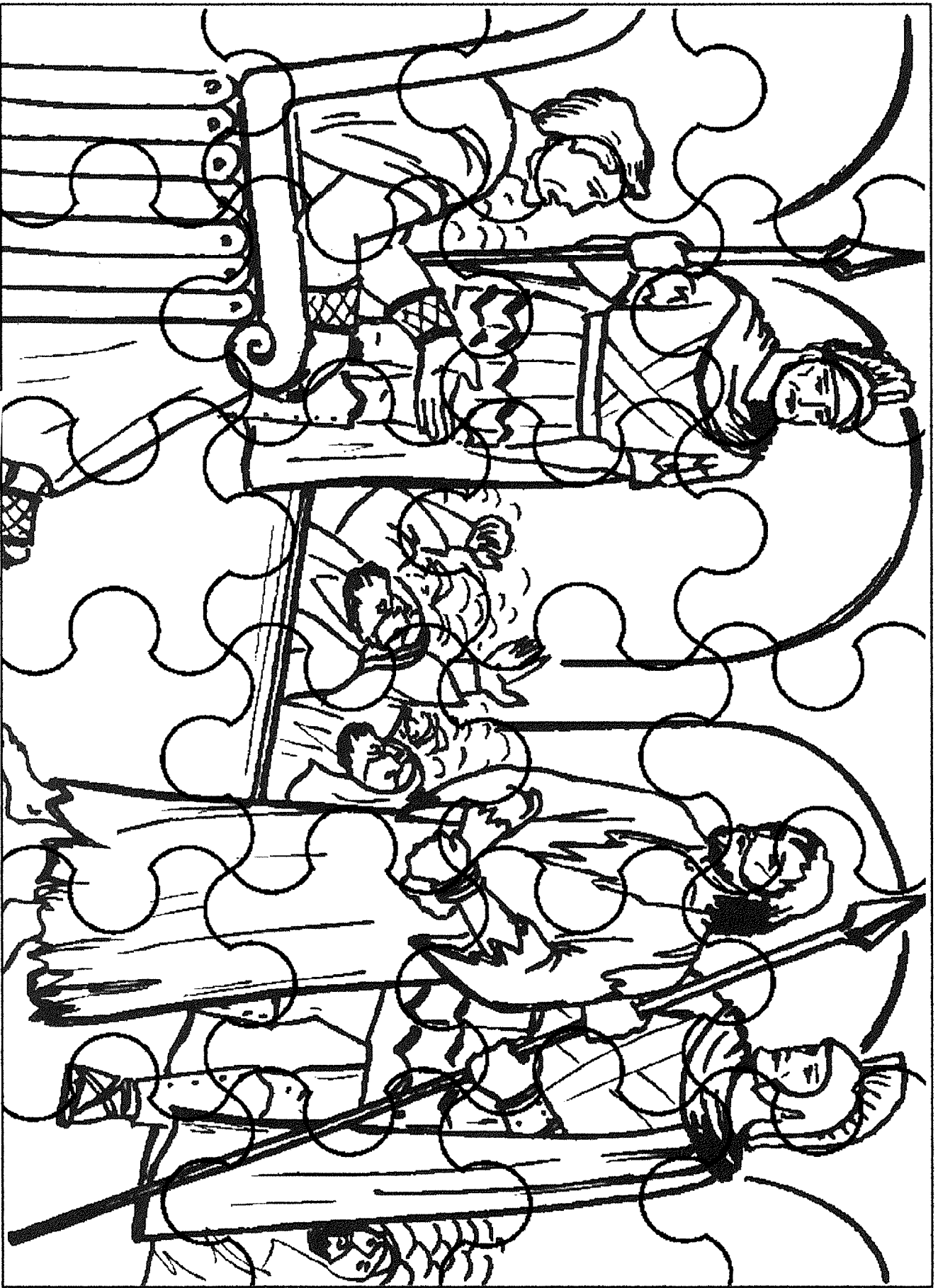
Jesus Nailed to the Cross

Scriptures: Matt 27:1-38, Luke 23:1-38

Key Verse: Luke 23:34 Then Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do.”

Key Points:

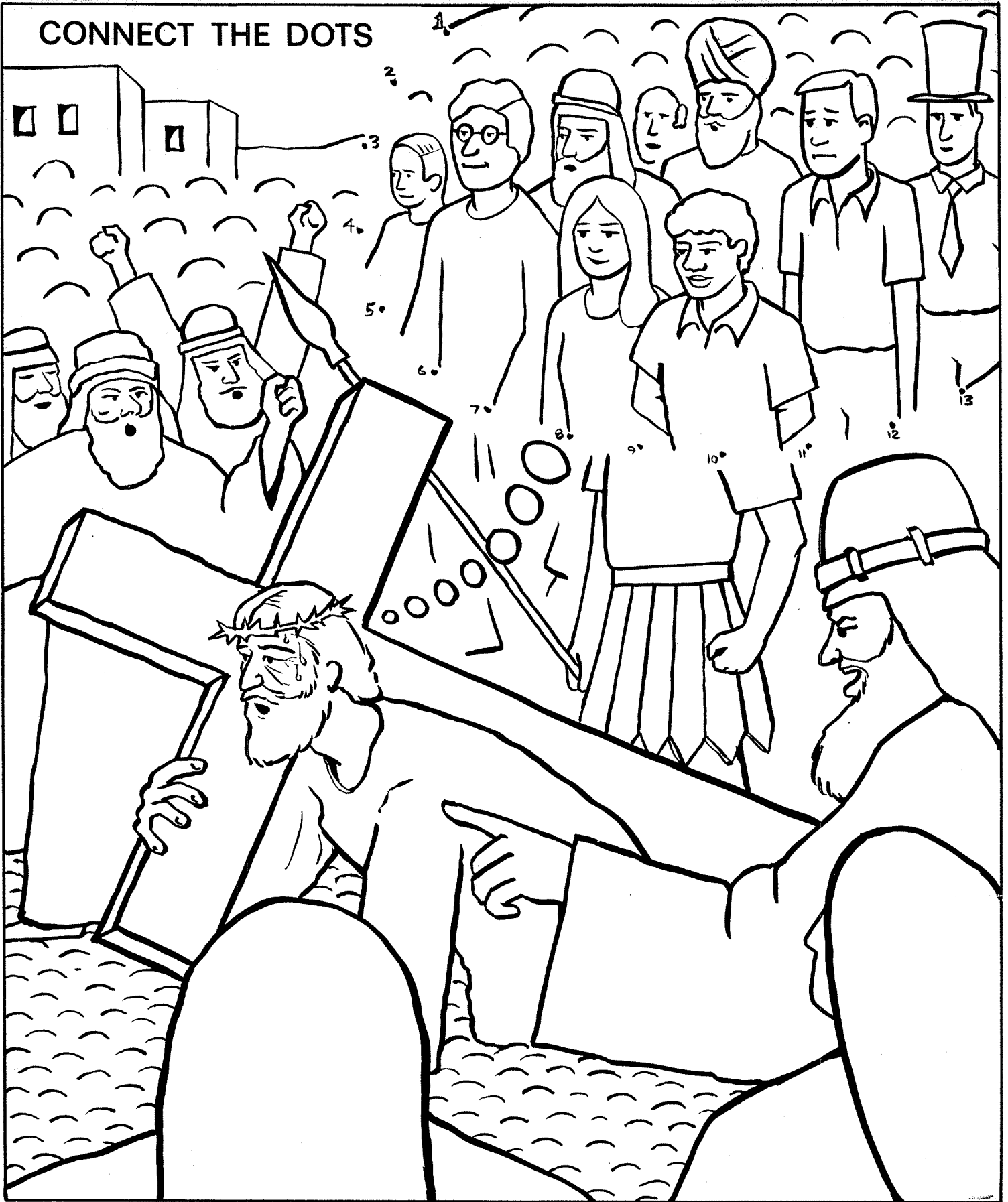
1. The chief priests and elders bound Jesus and the Jews led him to Pontius Pilate, the governor of Judea. Pilate asked him, “Are you the king of the Jews?” He answered, “It is as you say.” But Jesus did not say anything in response to the accusations by the chief priests and elders.
2. When Judas saw that Jesus was condemned, he was remorseful and tried to return the money he had received to betray Jesus. Judas threw the money on the floor of the temple, and went out and hanged himself. The priests used the money to buy the potter’s field as was prophesied in Jeremiah 32:6-9.
3. When Pilate discovered Jesus was from Galilee, he sent Jesus to Herod. Herod wanted to question Jesus and witness a miracle, but Jesus remained silent. Herod’s men mocked Jesus and sent Him back to Pilate.
4. Pilate wanted to release Jesus because he had done nothing wrong. It was usual to release a Jewish prisoner during the Passover feast, and Pilate suggested that Jesus should go free. The people protested, and shouted for Barabbas, a murderer, to be freed and for Jesus to be crucified. Pilate washed his hands, and said he was innocent of the death of Jesus.
5. The soldiers dressed Jesus in a scarlet robe and crown of thorns, and mocked Him, saying “Hail, king of the Jews”. They spat on Him and struck His head. Then, they dressed Him in his own clothes and took him away. A man named Simon was forced to help Jesus carry the cross.
6. At Golgotha, Jesus was crucified between two robbers, and his garments were divided. The charge against Jesus was written above His head; THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS. Some of the people and soldiers challenged Him to save Himself.
