Sea of Galilee and the Ascension

Scriptures: John 21, Acts 1:1-14

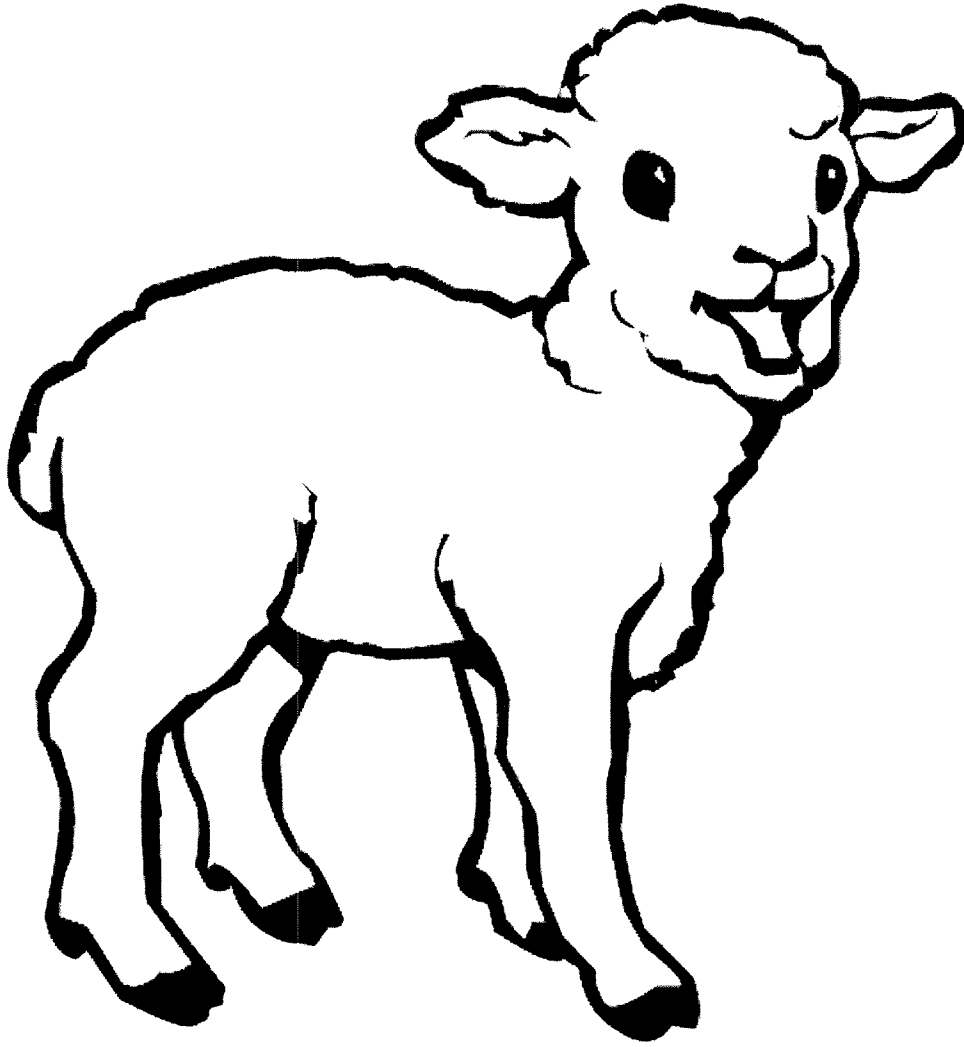
Key Verse: Acts 1:8 “But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Key Points:

- 1.** Peter and some of the disciples went fishing. By morning, they had not caught anything. A man (Jesus, but the disciples did not know who it was) called from the shore, asking if they had food. He told them to cast the net on the right side of the boat to find some.
- 2.** They did so, and the net was filled with so many fish that they were unable to draw it in. John said to Peter, “It is the Lord!” and Peter dove into the water. The other disciples brought the boat to shore, dragging the net with fish. At the shore, there was a fire with fish and bread. Jesus fed them a breakfast of bread and fish.
- 3.** After breakfast, Jesus asked Peter, “Do you love me more than these?” Peter answered, “Yes Lord, you know that I love you.” Jesus said, “Feed my lambs.” Jesus repeated this two more times. Then Jesus told Peter that his death would glorify God and to follow Him until death.
- 4.** John testifies that the events recorded in his book are true, and that if all the things that Jesus did were written, the world could not contain all the books.
- 5.** Jesus taught the believers about the kingdom of God for forty days after the resurrection. He commanded them to stay in Jerusalem until they had received the Promise of the Father, that is the power of the Holy Spirit.
- 6.** While they watched, Jesus was taken up into the sky, and a cloud hid Him from their sight. Two men in white appeared and told them that Jesus would return from the heavens the same way they had seen him taken away.

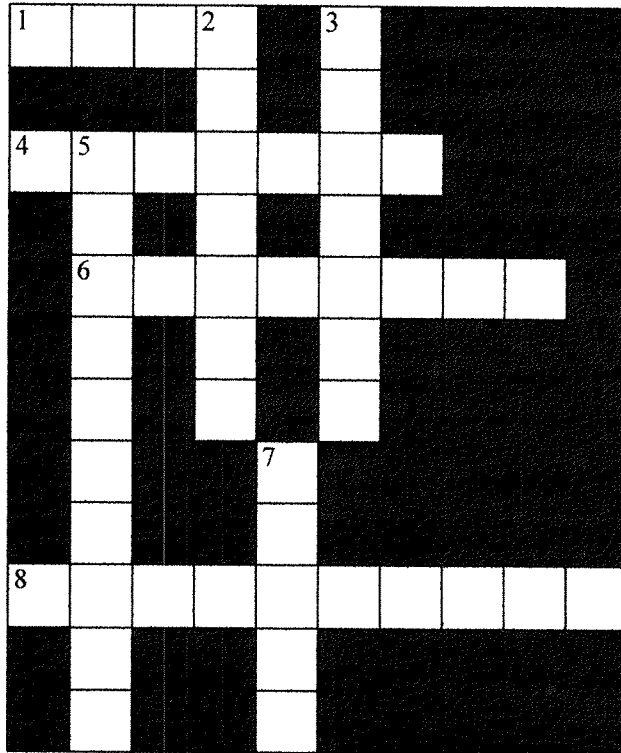
