Rainbow of Promise

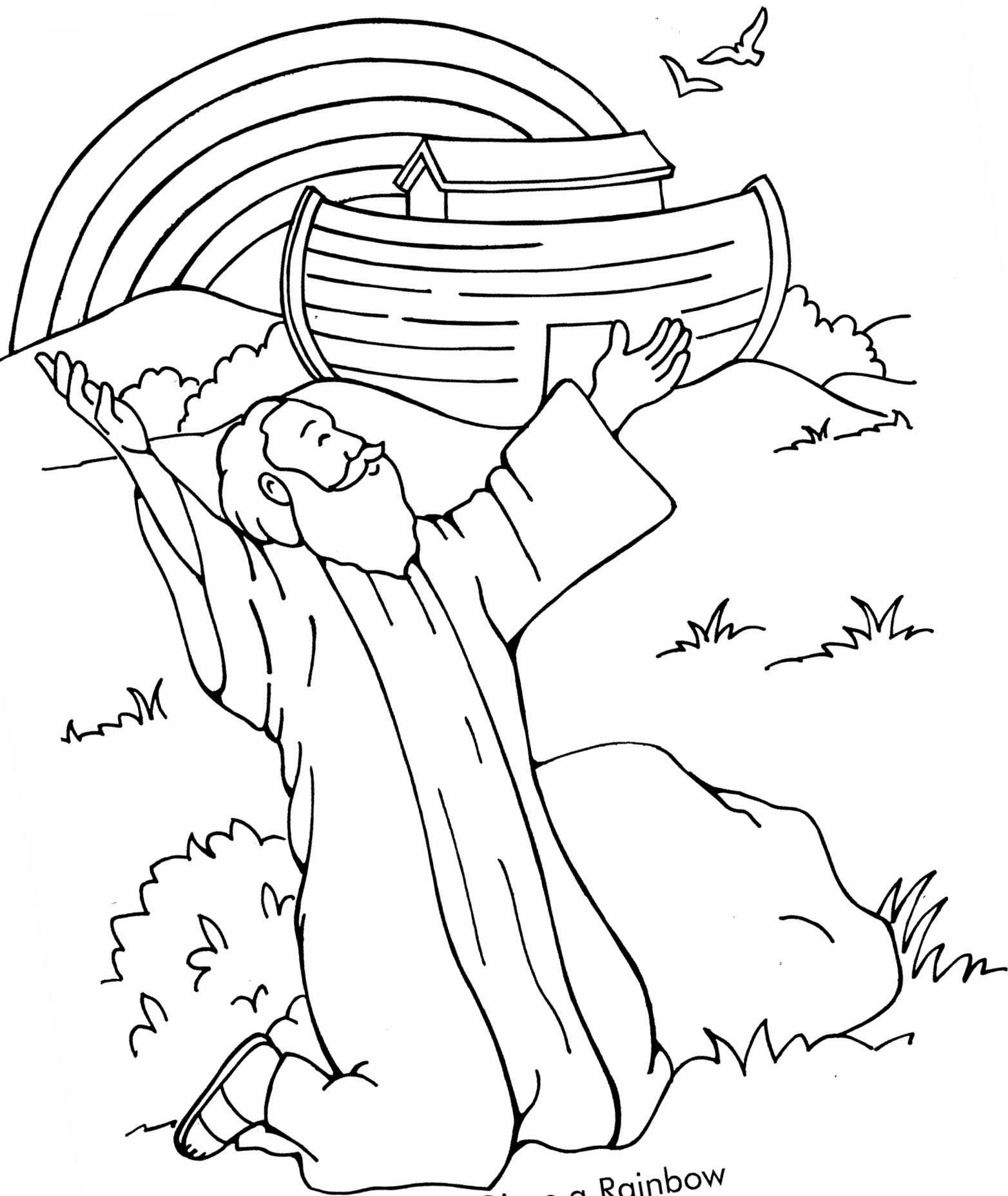
Scriptures: Genesis 8 & 9

Key Verse:

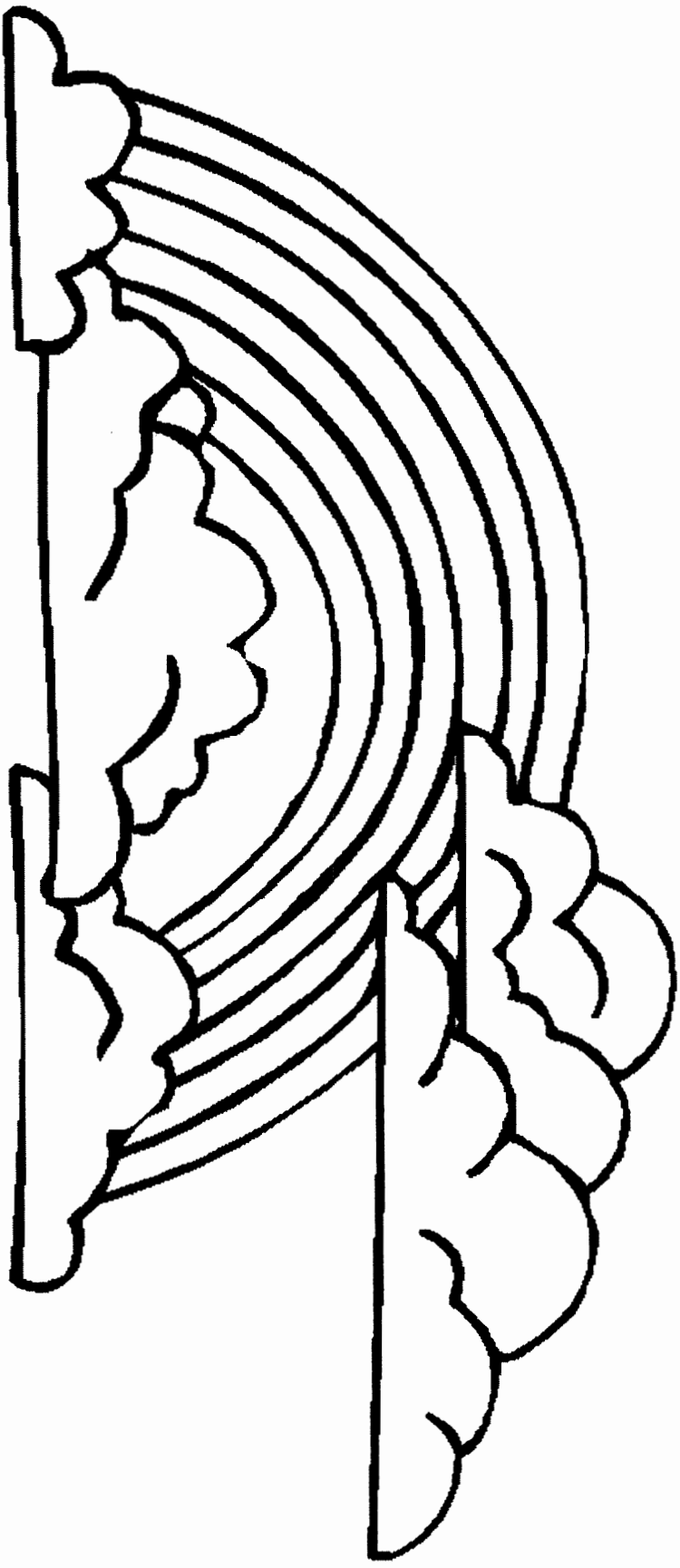
Genesis 9:13 "I set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth."

Key Points:

- 1.** The waters totally covered the earth but God remembered Noah and sent a wind to dry the waters. The waters were on the earth many months before they began recede.
- 2.** Noah sent a raven and a dove to see if the earth was dry.
- 3.** After about a year, God commanded Noah, his family and animals to leave the ark. Noah immediately built an altar and worshiped God for His saving protection.
- 4.** God set up seasons that He promised would not cease. Animals would be given to man to eat.
- 5.** God made a covenant (promise) to never again destroy the earth by water. He put a rainbow in the sky as a symbol to remind man of His promises.
