Key Verse: Gen. 22:18 "In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed my voice."




- 1. God tested Abraham by asking him to sacrifice his only son.

Abraham and Isaac Mountain Maze


Follow the maze to see the route that Abraham took Isaac up to the mountain to sacrifice the lamb.


Abraham and Isaac Worship on the Mountain


