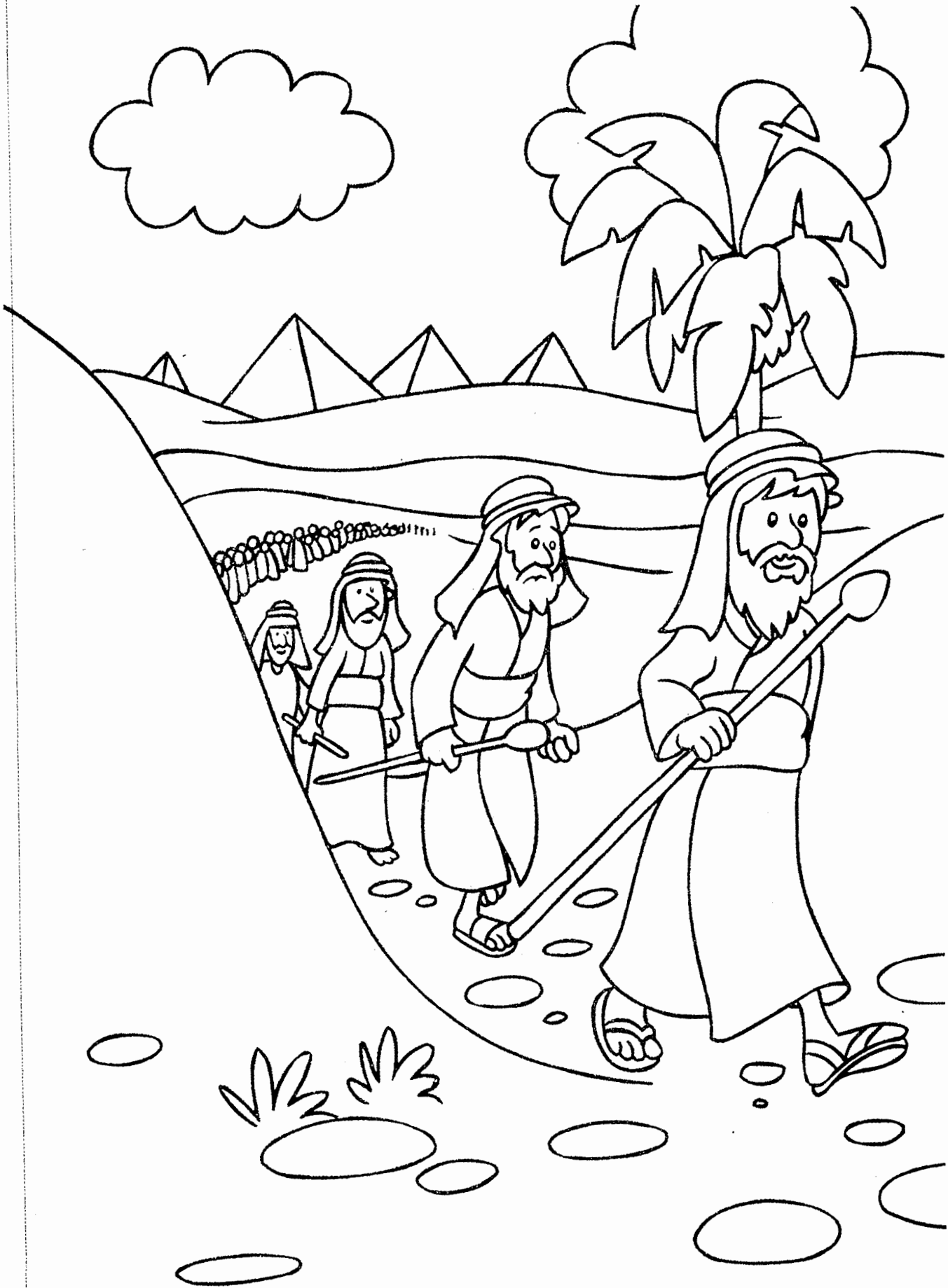
Crossing the Red Sea

Key Verse: Exodus 14:14 The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace.

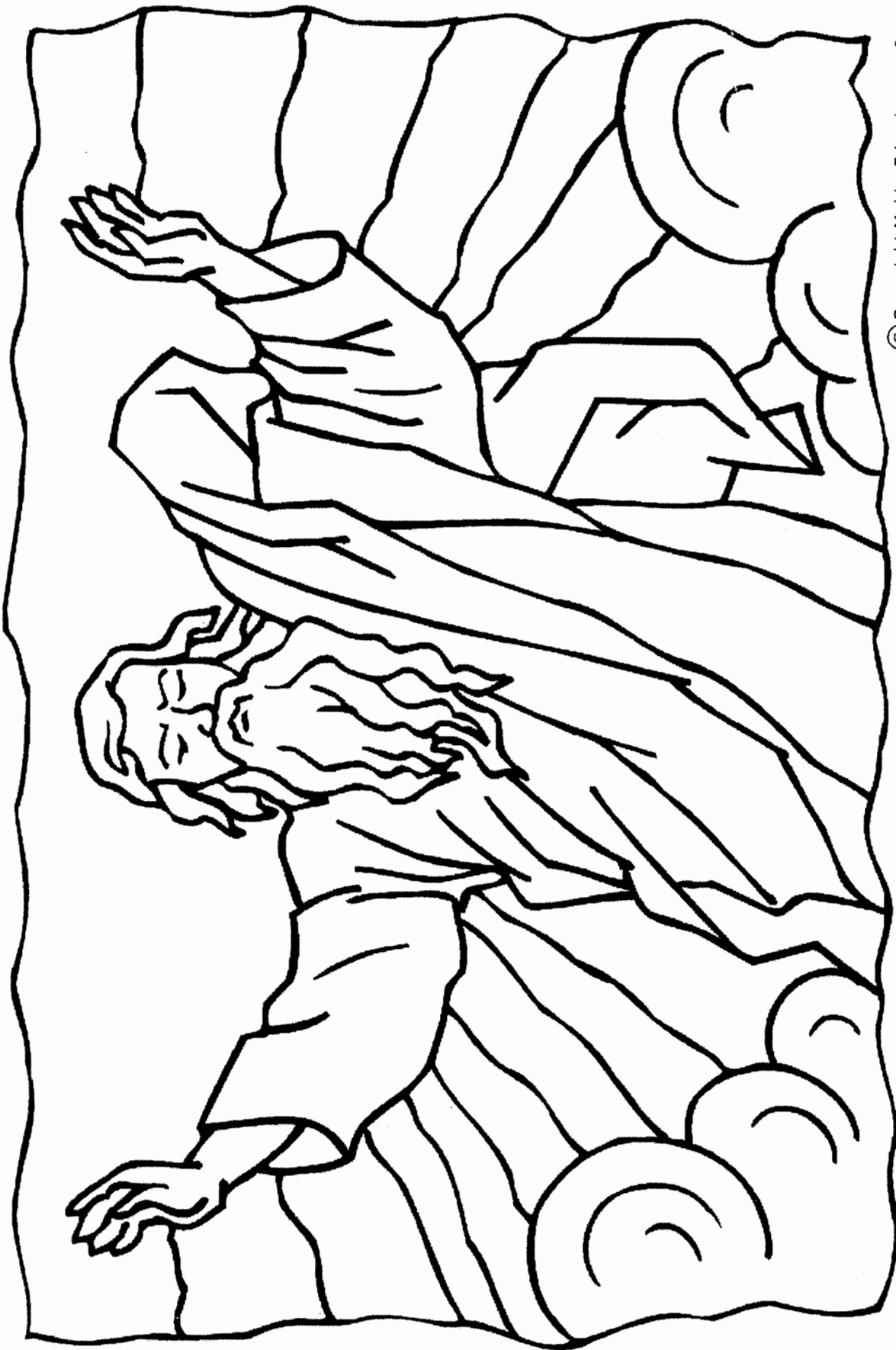
Key Points:

1. Pharaoh's army pursued the Israelites. The Israelites panicked when they saw the army, and thought they would die. They were ready to give up.
2. Moses spoke to God, and He sent a strong wind to hold the waters of the sea into a wall.
3. The Israelites crossed the sea on dry land.
4. When the army followed them into the sea, God caused the water wall to collapse and kill all of the Egyptians.
5. God hears our prayers, and will always help us when we are following his will.
