### **The Tabernacle**

**Scriptures: Exodus 35 - 40**

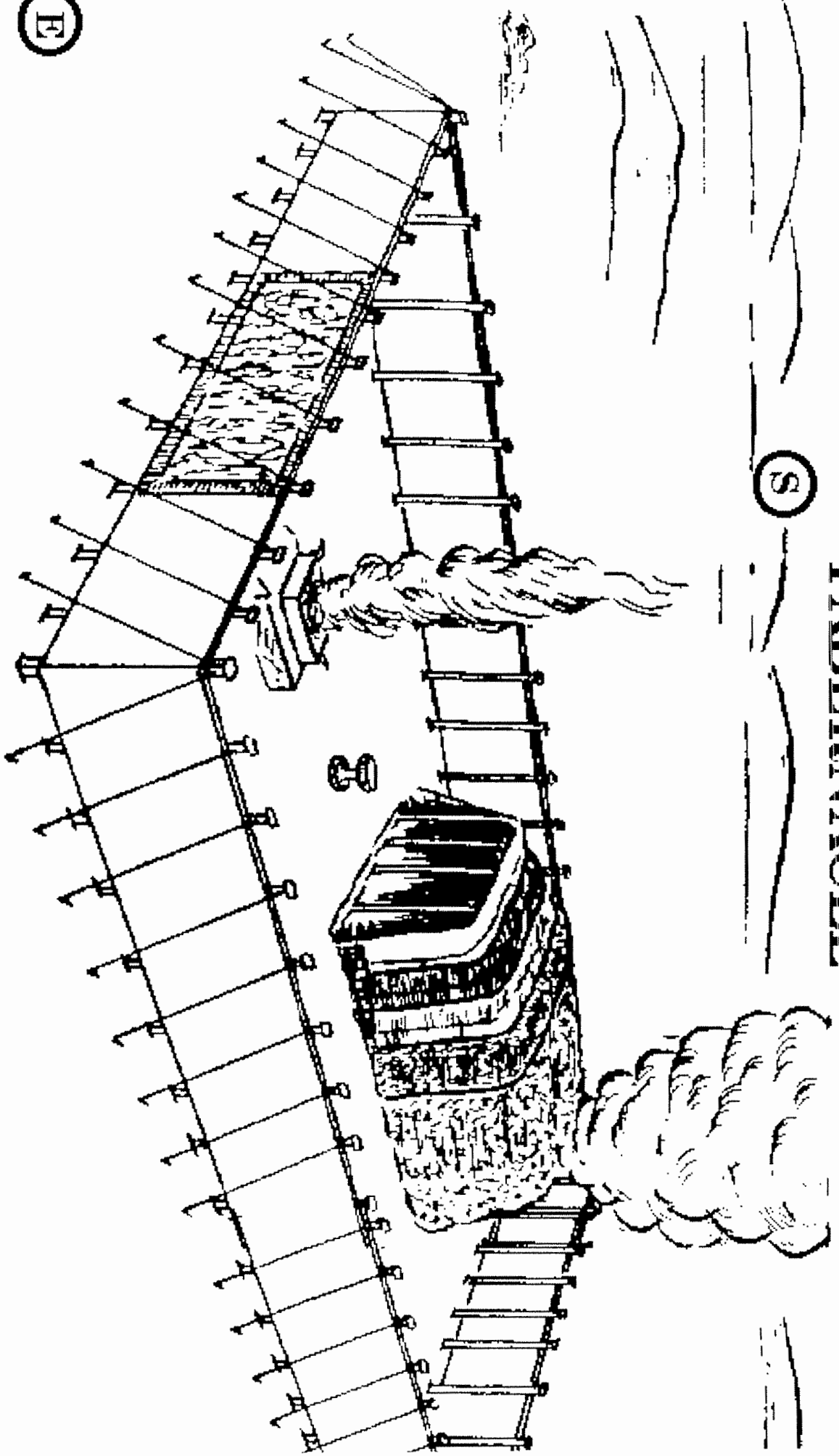
**Key Verse: Exodus 25:8 “And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.”**

#### **Key Points:**

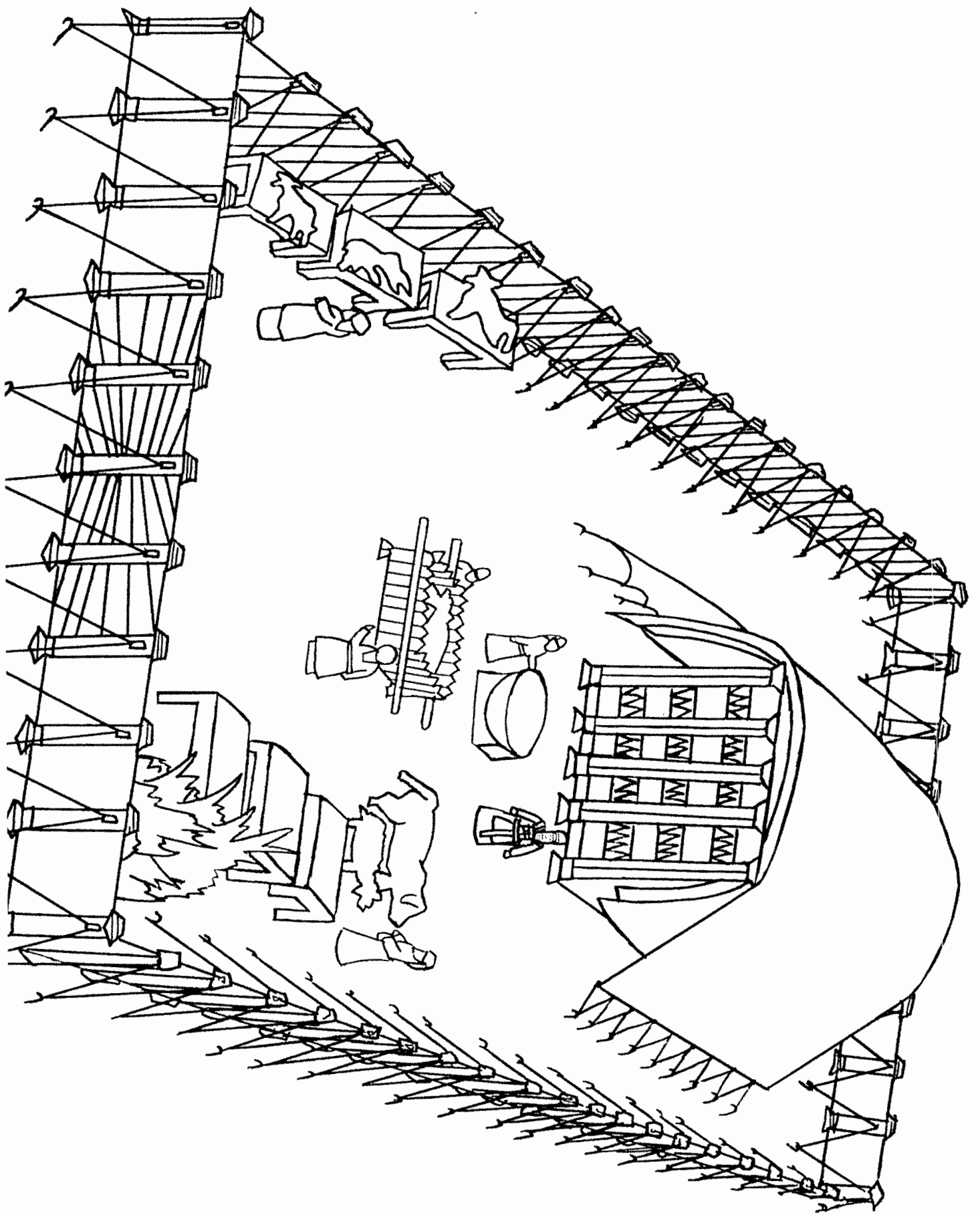
1. Moses gathers the people together and tells them that God commands that they should work for 6 days and rest on the Sabbath (7<sup>th</sup> day) for it is holy.
2. The Lord had given Moses instructions to build a tabernacle of meeting while on Mt. Sinai. The children of Israel were to bring offerings from a willing heart. Gold, silver, bronze, linens, etc. (Ex. 35:4-9), to be used to build the tabernacle. All who had whose hearts were stirred brought these offerings to Moses.
3. Gifted artisans were requested to come build the tabernacle and its contents, furniture and courts. God filled them with special abilities to do this work.
4. Details of the tabernacle: Tent, courtyard, altars, holy place, most holy place and their respective furnishings and uses. Touch on these, they will be taught more in depth in later classes. God gave instructions on how to worship, offerings and feasts.
5. The tabernacle was anointed as God specified and HIS glory filled the tabernacle-this was the special worship place of the children of Israel. The tabernacle moved when they moved. They were to follow the cloud and pillar of fire as they set out on their journeys.

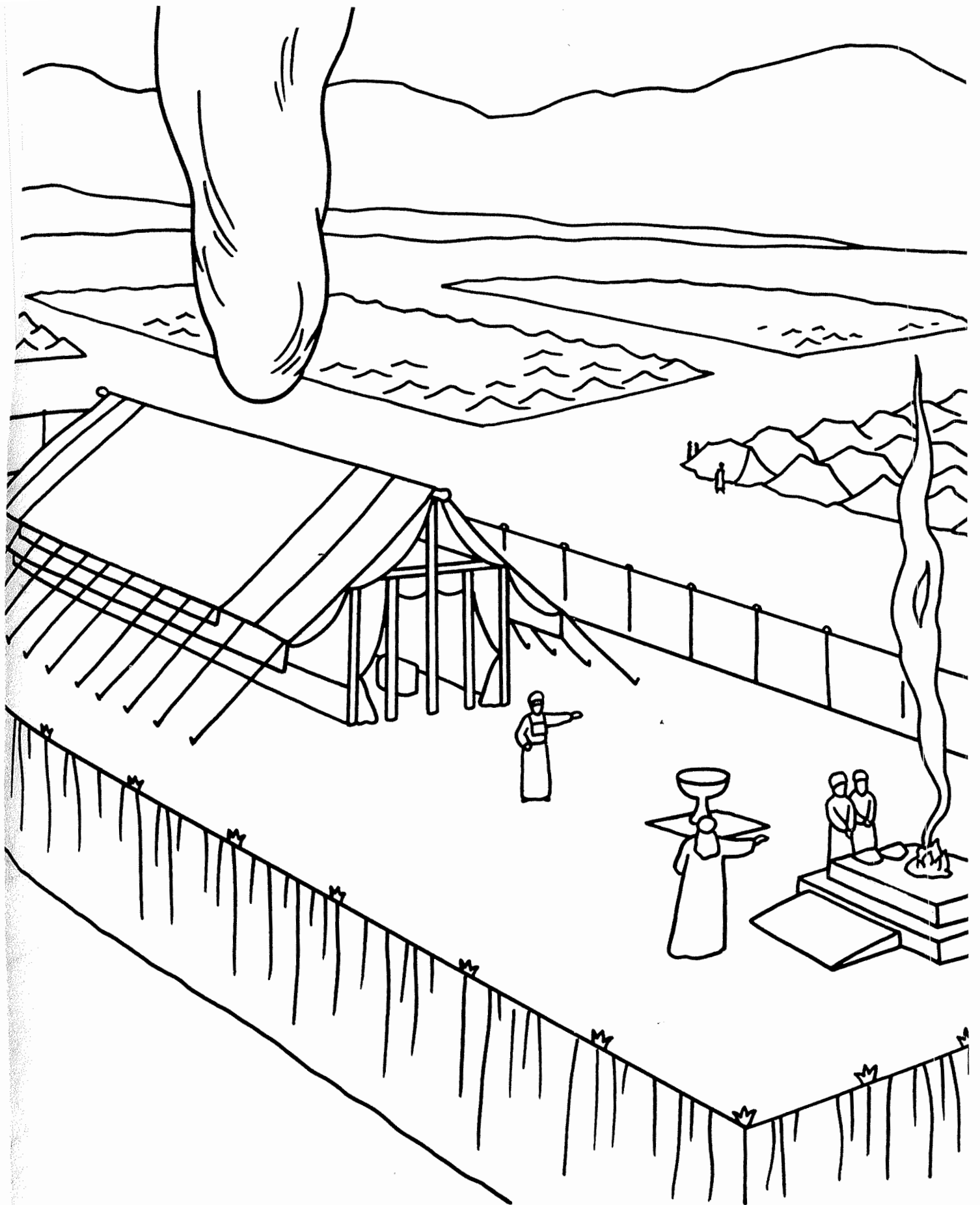

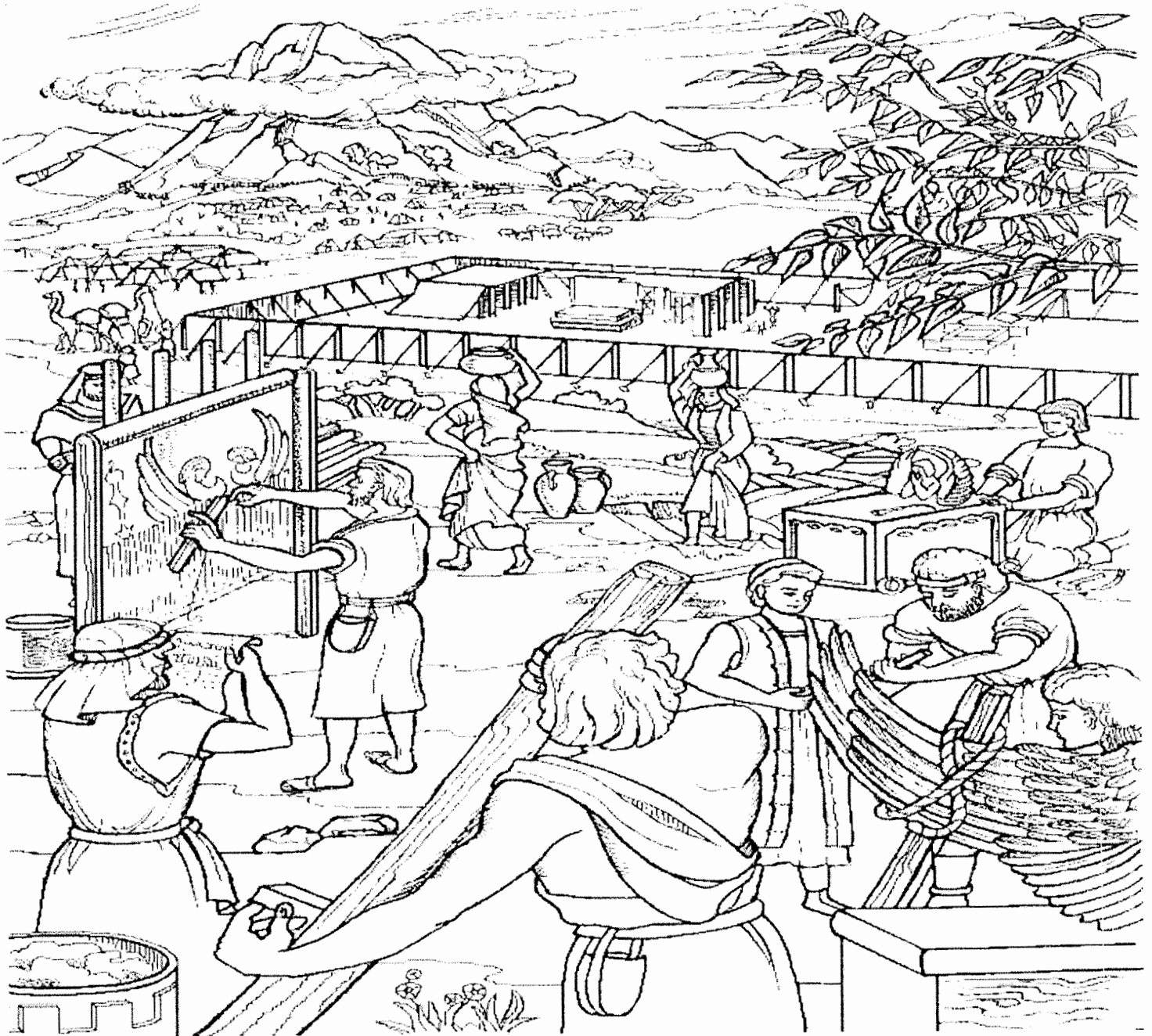


God told His people to build a tabernacle—a large, beautiful tent—as a house of worship. This could be moved from place to place.

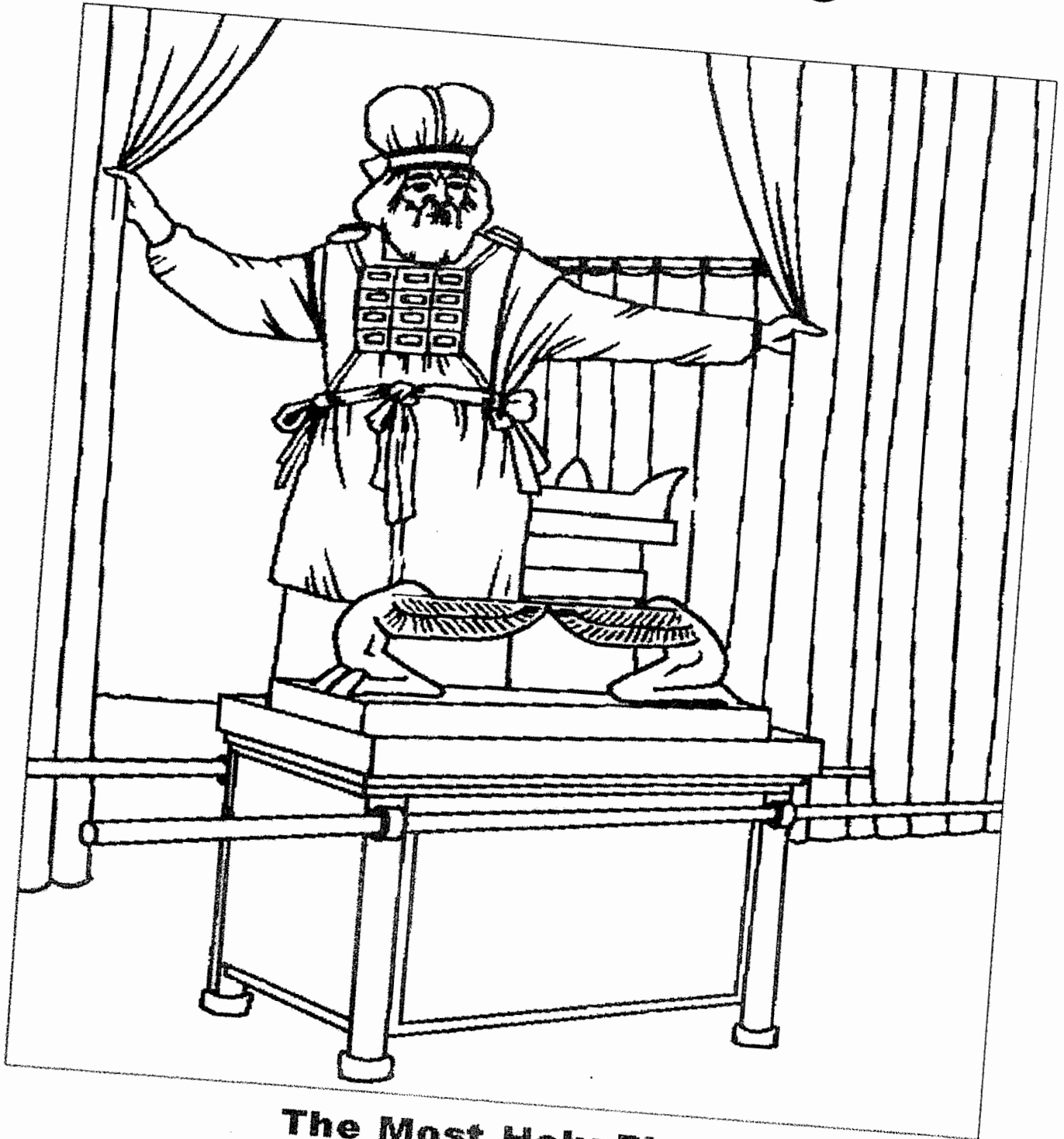

# Building The Tabernacle

God wanted to dwell among His people in the desert, so He instructed the Israelites to build a home or Tabernacle where His presence would be with them. God instructed the Israelites at Mount Sinai to build a special tent or Tabernacle "*where I will meet with you* (Exodus 25:22)." It was also known as the *House of the Lord* and the *Tent of Meeting*.

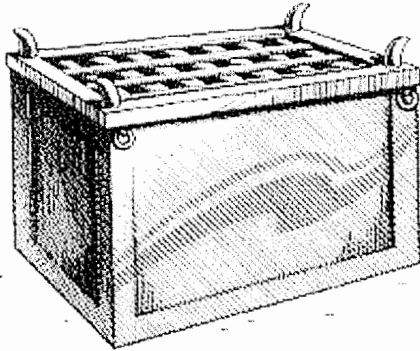


# The Tabernacle in the Wilderness

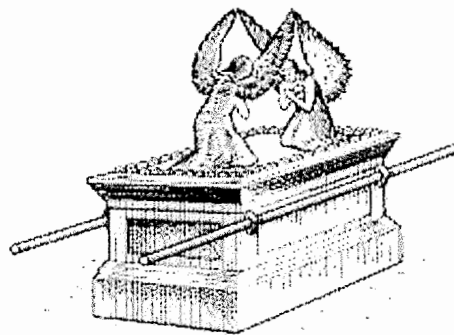

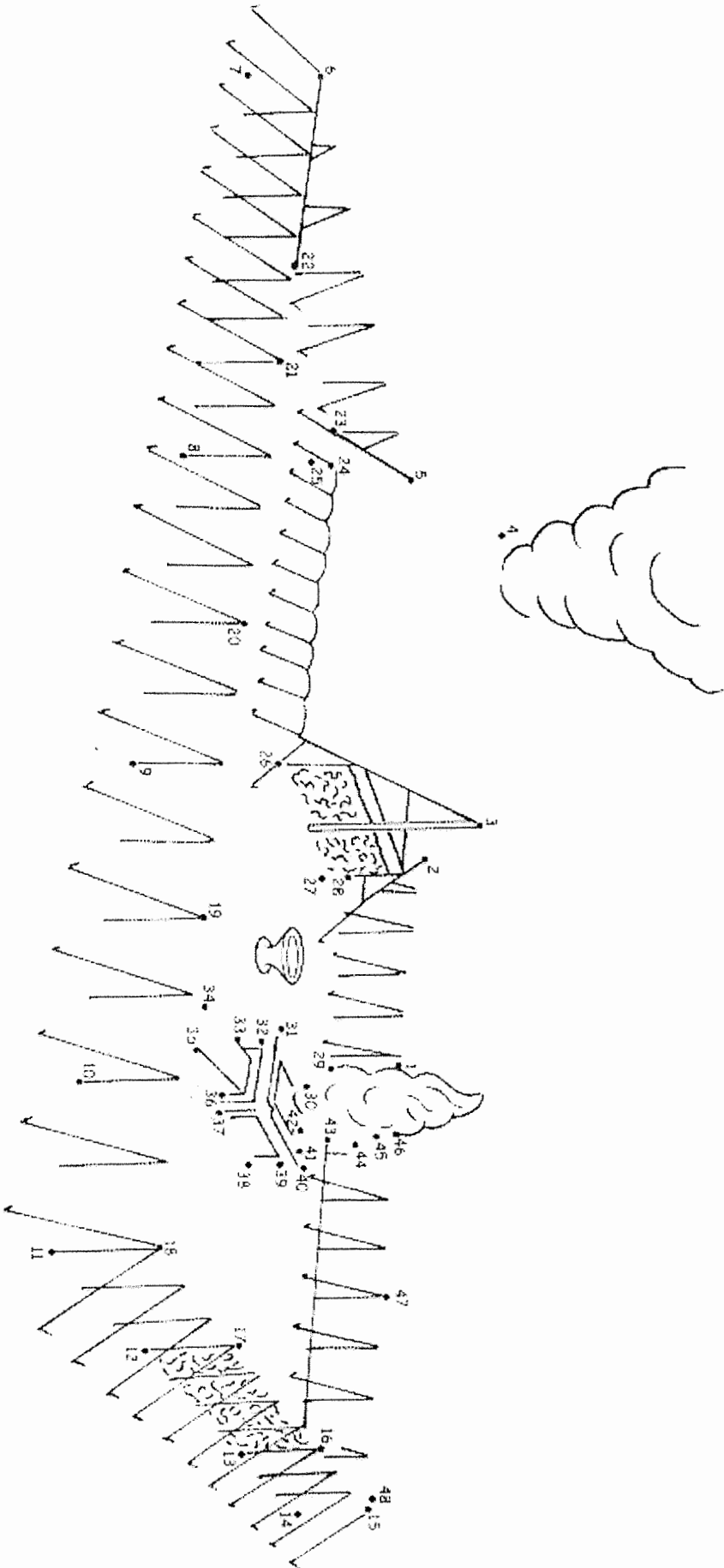

After the Israelites left Egypt, God gave Moses careful instructions for building a Holy Tent called a tabernacle. This special tent could be carried with the people wherever they went so they could worship God anywhere. God asked the people to give what they had to build the tabernacle. The people gave so much that Moses had to tell them to stop giving. God wants us to give willingly to His work too.
